"We reached goals we never thought possible."

To say Davia Pilley felt overwhelmed after the birth of her son, Ezra, is an understatement. Ezra was born at Children's Hospital of the King's Daughters in Norfolk and spent several weeks in the NICU due to a series of physical conditions, including cerebral palsy, a gene mutation, and fluid on the brain.

"I was told I needed to reach out to CDR because of his conditions," said Davia. "I had no clue what to do, and I knew I needed help. It's so scary when you hear a frightening prognosis. The fear of the unknown is awful."

CDR immediately assessed Ezra, and an **Infant & Parent Program** care coordinator helped identify necessary steps to implement a plan to help him, including starting immediately with CDR physical therapists. Davia had found the support she needed during this difficult time. "It helped me cope and move forward in a positive direction," she said.

CDR's assistance and caring attitude made all the difference to Davia and Ezra.

"CDR has been with us every step of the way, from helping us get a walker for Ezra to showing me how to work with him to improve his skills," said Davia. "The CDR staff helped me overcome emotions that were holding me back."

In addition to the necessary physical therapy sessions, Davia said **Developmental Playgroup** helped her young son learn how to interact with other adults and children his own age.

"Playgroup really helped Ezra prepare for preschool," Davia said. "The interaction he had with other toddlers made a lasting impact on him."

"It's so scary to think your child may not be able to do things that other children can do. But Ezra has reached goals that he wasn't supposed to reach. We are so grateful for all that CDR has done for us."

Infant & Parent Program (IPP)...

- O Served 19 sets of twins.
- Provided 3,392 hours of education, occupational, physical, and speech therapies to young children and their families.
- Helped families connect to important community resources through referrals to neurologists and other medical specialists, preschools, and community providers.
- Provided specialized therapies and services to 501 children. Of these children, 229 transitioned out of the program, with 30% moving into preschool special education and 39% discharged because they "caught up" and no longer needed developmental assistance.

"We overcame challenges as a team."

Having already raised a 17-year-old, Kiajani Davis thought her second chance at parenting would be easy. But things didn't go as planned.

"There have been a lot of changes in 17 years," she said, "and I wasn't sure I was getting this parenting thing right." To add to her concerns, her infant daughter, Alonah, was not hitting her developmental milestones, and an added history of deafness in the family gave Kiajani a lot to worry about.

Soon after contacting CDR, Alonah was assessed for developmental delays and other benchmarks and was immediately enrolled in the **Early Head Start** program. Kiajani and Alonah now receive weekly visits, parenting support, and instruction from Gwen, a CDR family advocate. Before the pandemic, Kiajani participated in CDR's **Parent Group** while her daughter worked on developing her skills in CDR's **Developmental Playgroup**.

Alonah's hearing is also constantly monitored and evaluated, and soon she will begin speech and occupational therapy, said her mother. In the meantime, Alonah and Kiajani work with Gwen to encourage Alonah to develop her fine and gross motor skills, sensory issues, and social development with peers and other adults.

"We're working together to help Alonah get through her challenges. She gets excited when it's time to work with Gwen," said Kiajani.

In just a short few months, Alonah's progress included recognizing faces and people, learning how to use utensils, turning the pages of a book, and recognizing pictures.

During the early weeks of the pandemic, Kiajani was worried her daughter's progress would regress due to office shutdowns and social distancing guidelines. While in-person visits have come to a temporary halt due to the pandemic, mom and daughter still meet with Gwen virtually once a week. "Gwen has gone above and beyond for our family, and CDR helped me realize I'm not alone. I am truly grateful," says Kiajani.

Early Head Start (EHS)...

- Temporarily merged CDR's two childcare centers into one for eight weeks during the summer of 2019, while necessary maintenance was performed.
- Celebrated four staff members who completed their Child Development Associate (CDA) degrees and another who completed her bachelor's degree in Early Elementary Education.
- Served 218 children from low-income households and 28 prenatal women.
- Helped parents thrive as their child's first teacher through weekly home visits with an EHS family advocate.

Parents as Teachers (PAT)...

- Launched a new initiative offering services to parents of children 3-6 years old, the Circle of Parents (COP) program, which fosters an open exchange of ideas, support, resources, and information in a format jointly facilitated by trained parents and staff.
- Attended the **PAT** annual international conference in St. Louis.
- Underwent successful site visits from funders representing the Maternal, Infant, and Early Childhood Home Visiting Program and the Community Action Partnership.
- Transitioned all families to virtual-based home visits during the pandemic.

"Because of CDR, everything is going to be fine."

Parenting a teenager with special needs and a toddler at the same time has been difficult for Rolana Mreich. But her struggles were enhanced when she and her family moved to Virginia a few years ago. Leaving her support group of family and friends behind in Florida was difficult for Rolana, and at the time she was just beginning to learn English, making things even more challenging.

"It is so hard when you don't have family and friends around you to help," she said. "I felt overwhelmed and didn't know what to do."

Everything changed when Rolana's husband found out about CDR's **Parents as Teachers** program and encouraged her to reach out.

"I was looking for help for me, but also for my toddler, Matthew. He wasn't speaking, and I was worried," she said.

Matthew was assessed by CDR and soon thereafter began receiving speech therapy from CDR's **Infant & Parent Program**. At the same time, his mom enjoyed home visits from CDR's Parents as Teachers Parent Educators. At their encouragement, Rolana also joined **CDR's Parent Group** for even more support while Matthew participated in **Developmental Playgroup**.

The connections Rolana made through CDR has made all the difference to her, and her son's therapies are helping Matthew make great progress with speech and other developmental milestones.

"CDR has helped me with every aspect of my life," Rolana said. "When I am sad, I have someone to talk to; when I need advice, I have a network to help me. I can share my feelings about my challenges, and I get the support I need."

Rolana adds that her English speaking skills have also improved since her involvement with CDR. "My friends at CDR encourage me and help me to grow. Matthew has made friends and learned so many skills. I know that because of CDR, everything is going to be fine."

"It was the lifeline I needed."

Running an early childcare center is challenging under normal circumstances, but when the pandemic hit in March, Callie Smith found herself in unchartered waters.

Callie is the Director of Highland Children's House, a childcare program near Staunton, Virginia. "We really didn't have any experience dealing with something like this," said Smith of the pandemic. "It was a scary scenario for all of us. Businesses were shutting their doors, schools were closing, and it was all happening so fast. We didn't really know how to proceed."

But help soon came to Callie and other childcare providers across the state when they heard from the **Virginia Infant & Toddler Specialist Network (VA ITSN)**.

"They reached out to us in so many ways, and it was wonderful to have the professional support that we really needed," she said. "We didn't know if we were taking the right precautions, so having their guidance made all the difference to us."

Within a matter of weeks, VA ITSN helped Callie and other directors with many of the details and procedures they needed to put in place before they could reopen their doors, including providing the funds and contractors needed to thoroughly clean and sanitize their centers.

"It was a huge relief to have that help when I needed it the most," said Callie.

Support also came in other ways. "The Network planned virtual informational sessions for me and other directors. The support and encouragement we gave each other was so important. We needed to know that we weren't alone, and that we were all going through many of the same experiences and emotions. Together we worked on how to plan, prioritize, and work through this tough time. It was very validating to have that support while it was all happening."

Callie is convinced that without the support of VA ITSN she doesn't know if she could have made it through those first few months of confusion. "It was the lifeline I needed," she said.

Virginia Infant & Toddler Specialist Network (VA ITSN)...

- Provided a \$300 cleaning stipend and/ or financial support for deep cleaning to more than 300 infant and toddler child care programs in response to COVID-19.
- Provided social/emotional services to infants and toddlers, as well as their families, from VA ITSN mental health consultants.
- Provided technical and financial support to programs wanting to (a) expand infant and toddler classrooms, (b) create breastfeeding space, and (c) become a more inclusive program. This allowed
 96 additional infants and 253 toddlers to enroll in those programs.

"Support from CDR made all the difference."

When Aleksandra Boitiere's daughter was born, the new mother knew she wanted to breastfeed her infant, but breastfeeding didn't come easily to her.

"It took nearly four weeks for my milk to come in, and my daughter was losing weight because of it," she said. The situation left Aleksandra upset and unsure about what to do.

To make things more complicated, Aleksandra searched the internet to find ways to encourage her milk production and solve other breastfeeding challenges, but the information was inconsistent, leaving her confused and frustrated. "I was jumping from one solution to another, and nothing was working."

Frustrated and feeling defeated, Aleksandra turned to her doctor for advice, and that's when she learned about CDR's breastfeeding support services.

"Initially, I thought I could handle my situation, but having support from CDR made all the difference to me and my newborn," Aleksandra said.

Aleksandra began working with CDR's International Board Certified Lactation Consultants, who helped her increase her milk production and improve latching techniques. In addition, Aleksandra found the emotional support she needed from other moms facing breastfeeding challenges in the group.

"Talking to other moms was so helpful," she said. "I didn't grow up around a lot of babies, and I needed the support that the program offered me."

In addition to breastfeeding support services, Aleksandra participated in CDR's **Infant Massage** classes, learning how to soothe her baby and help her through colicky moments and to relax before bedtime. "The techniques I learned have become a part of our daily routine," she said. "I am so very grateful and happy for the help I received from CDR. It gave me peace of mind and helped me understand how to help my baby."

Motherhood...

- O Served 161 babies, 162 moms, and 1 dad.
- Staff received the "Virginia Breastfeeding Friendly Workplace Gold Award" from the Virginia Breastfeeding Coalition.
- Trained 14 CDR staff members in infant massage.
- Established a weekly drive-up baby "weighin" station during the pandemic so that parents could continue to track their baby's weight gain.
- Continued breastfeeding support groups, infant massage classes, and Mothers and Babies programs virtually to meet the needs of parents during the pandemic.

"I never lost my lifeline and support system."

A challenging child custody battle left Robert Jefferson depressed and, at times, almost despondent. At the time, the father of three boys was a stay-at-home dad, happily parenting his children. But court challenges and the exhaustion of constantly fighting for custody of his youngest, who was only 4, left Robert feeling alone and hopeless.

When his mother heard about CDR's **Fatherhood Program**, she immediately passed the information on to her son. "I called right away," said Robert. "People don't understand how difficult it is for dads to find the support they need."

Participating in a Fatherhood Program class was energizing to Robert, and the support he received in the class made him realize he was not alone. "I realized that other dads have the same problems and obstacles that I have," he said. "We open up to each other, and that has helped me learn perspective."

While discussing fatherhood topics such as discipline, bonding, home activities, listening, and finances in the class, Robert also works closely with CDR Fatherhood Consultant, Oliver Walman.

"Oliver has been there for me from the beginning. He showed me that men can overcome a lot of things if they channel their feelings appropriately. It feels great for a man to talk with a man about what they are going through. I get a positive energy boost from it," he said.

In addition to setting goals and tracking his accomplishments, Robert said the periodic checks he receives from Oliver help him stay on track of his long-term parenting plan.

"I really thought that when the pandemic hit I would lose my lifeline with the Fatherhood Program, but before I knew it we were meeting online and picking up our conversations virtually," Robert said. "That was such a concern for me, because I needed the support more than ever. I truly thank CDR for helping me realize how much I needed this program and how many good fathers there are out there that I can turn to for support."

- Enrolled over 300 fathers in CDR's
 Fatherhood Program, providing education, support, and assistance in reaching their goals as fathers.
- Hosted a December family event with over 81 fathers, mothers, and children.
- O Offered 24/7[®] Dad classes to encourage effective communication and nurturing fatherhood practices.
- Conducted 24/7[®] Dad workshop training for 45* incarcerated fathers in the Newport News and Virginia Peninsula Regional Jails; many continued in the program upon release.
